THE HOUSING BILL was passed by parliament on 12th May, but the fight against it has only just begun. Tenant and housing groups, councils, academics, trade unions and communities all say this Act is wrong – now we need to stand together to defy and defeat it.

Tenants can organise to boycott the pay-to-stay tax, to resist evictions, and to block regeneration and estate demolitions. Councils and housing associations should refuse

to do the Tory government's dirty work. This is how we will stop this.

We will:

- Keep up the campaign against the Act at every stage and demand it is scrapped
- Organise with tenants in every local area to resist its implementation
- Call on councils, housing associations, trade unions and others to work with us to challenge, resist and defy the Act
- Block 'regeneration' schemes that lead to social cleansing

- Call on all opposition parties to support this fight and commit to repeal of the Housing and Planning Act
- The Tory Government
