Millions are already forced into private renting, in damp, overcrowded housing, with no long-term security. This Bill will make that worse, and hit the poorest, the most vulnerable and women fleeing violence, and cut Traveller sites and rights.

House prices make buying a dream most can't ever afford. Invest in the secure and really-affordable homes we need – free councils to build more council homes.
