Under the Housing Bill, council and housing association tenants with household income above £40,000 could see their rents triple. The speculative development boom sweeping through the borough is already pricing many local people out. Now developers will be able to make even more profit by building publicly subsidised 'Starter Homes' instead of genuinely affordable homes for rent. The Housing Bill will do nothing to improve the housing crisis. It will make it worse.

Scrapping secure tenancies will damage our communities and push more people into substandard private renting. Now David Cameron says he wants to 'bulldoze' some council estates. This is a land-grab. The Tory government doesn't care about social housing or our communities – they just want to make money out of them.
