£1M Wasted


Despite these forthcoming changes, the ruling group on South Cambs Council voted down a plan to postpone the privatisation ballot for a year.

They insisted on pressing ahead regardless, arguing that the £1M that they are spending on protransfer propaganda would otherwise be wasted!

No balance

This followed an earlier decision where the same councillors defeated by only three votes a proposal to provide tenants with balanced information, including the disadvantages of transfer.

Stop Press...... Govt. £175M off Council rents

Housing minister Margaret Beckett has announced £175M for councils to reduce this year's planned rent increases by half.

The cash is not available to housing associations, so widening the gap with council rents even further.

This is further proof that the Govt. has dropped its "rent convergence" policy, where Council rents were supposed to be increasing to the same high level as HAs.

Debts for tenants, profits for private Bankers!

The council has admitted that the proposed housing association would have to borrow £80Million to get off the ground.

Tenants would be saddled with this huge debt, with their homes used as collateral.

The loans would be at high commercial rates, (around £7M per year in interest alone) giving huge profits to the private banking fat cats, paid for from tenant's rents.
