Thousands of new homes are planned. The vast majority will be unaffordable to the people who live in this borough. Travellers sites and council estates are threatened. Homes on the Tustin Estate and the Aylesbury Estate are already earmarked for demolition, and the destruction has already started. Community halls and playgrounds are threatened with demolition and privatisation. Whole areas of local industry, with thousands of jobs, could be swept away.

But we have already pushed back against the Council and its friends in the development industry. Avlesbury leaseholders have delayed the compulsory purchase of their homes, campaigners in Lewisham have prevented one version of the disastrous Millwall development, an occupation of Thurlow Lodge Community Hall has stopped Southwark Council closing it and evicting a homeless charity. The Canada Estate TRA have halted a plan to demolish their homes. Mayflower TRA have put the brakes on the council's demolition plan for their hall. Determined resistance can finish off all these schemes.

We say: No demolition of council estates without a ballot. No more unelected steering groups to gain fake consent for demolition and privatisation. Rent control and secure tenancies for all.
