● Council tenants, on average across the UK, pay £2500 per year in rent. But councils are only allowed to spend around £1500 on our homes. The rest is siphoned off by government.

● £8 million was taken from Wrexham council last year - the Assembly plan to bankroll Tai Wreccsam by the same amount each year if the privatisation goes ahead!

● This is a scandal. Subsidising privatisation should stop. This money and the income from our rents and 'right to buy' receipts is enough to repair and improve our homes.
