'Fourth option': to improve existing council homes and estates and start a new council house building programme



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We're demanding the 'Fourth Option' for council housing as an alternative to privatisation and market madness.

Nearly three million council tenants across the UK want their local authority to improve all existing council homes and estates and more than 1.6 million households on council housing waiting lists – and many more in housing need – want local authorities to start building new council homes. We all want decent, affordable and secure council housing provided by an accountable landlord. We're demanding government stop siphoning money out of council housing and provide a level playing field on funding and debt write-off to enable councils to improve existing, build new and maintain all council housing as first class housing for years to come.
